Images should be between 800 and 2000px on their longest edge, in .jpeg, .png or .gif format. A maximum of 10 images or excerpts should be included per submission and they should have a total combined file size under 10MB.

Supporting documents and imagery can simply be attached to your application email. Please do not use zipped or compressed files/folders.

Audio and video files should not be attached, instead please include links to hosting sites such as Vimeo, Soundcloud, YouTube, etc.
